Social Skills (SCLC - Social and Cognitive Learning Center):

- SS.1 **Initiation of Conversation/Interaction** — practice introduction in a group setting.
- SS.2 **Maintenance of Conversation/Interaction** — practice maintaining interaction by being more interactive rather than having one-sided conversation.
- SS.3 **Repair** — practice knowing how to resolve a conflict/disagreement during group project in order to continue with project.
- SS.4 **Self-Advocacy** — practice voicing opinion effectively without appearing too “bossy”, “inflexible”, or “controlling”.
- SS.5 **Big Deal vs. Little Deal** — practice putting events into perspective in order to be able proceed with task.
- SS.6 **Negotiation** — practice sharing differing ideas and to come to a mutual resolution.
- SS.7 **Perspective Taking** — practice understanding feelings, intensions, and ideas of others and know they may be different than self.
- SS.8 **Hanging Out** — practice socializing during unstructured time.
- SS.9 **Social Eating** — practice integrating lunch and socializing as eating often related to social events.
- SS.10 **Sense of Belonging in a Group** — develop a sense of connection with the group and feel that they are a valued member of the group.
- SS.11 **Self-Identity/Self-Esteem** — develop a better understanding of their strengths and challenges and use that to develop a positive sense of self.
- SS.12 **Confidence** — increase confidence to be successful and enjoy self in a social setting through positive interactions with others.

Executive Functioning Skills (iROC):

- EF.1 **Impulse Control** — the ability to stop and think before acting
- EF.2 **Emotional Control** — the ability to manage feelings by thinking about goals
- EF.3 **Flexibility** — the ability to change strategies or revise plans when conditions change
- EF.4 **Working Memory** — the ability to hold information in mind and use it to complete a task (Camp Cogmed®)
- EF.5 **Self-Monitoring** — the ability to monitor and evaluate your own performance
- EF.6 **Planning and Setting Priorities** — the ability to create steps to reach a goal and to make decisions about what to focus on
- EF.7 **Task Initiation (Getting Started)** — the ability to recognize when it’s time to get started on something and then to begin without procrastinating
- EF.8 **Organization** — the ability to create and maintain systems to keep track of information or materials
